Colombia is the third largest coffee producer. Due to the large number of different microclimates Colombian coffee has a great diversity. 95% of coffee farms are less than 5 hectares in size. Most farmers process the cherries at their farms and then sell the coffee to local state or private procurement stations. Very often, farmers experiment with the berry processing process, which only adds to the diversity of Colombian lots.

The main regulators of the coffee sector in Colombia are the Federacion Nacional de Cafeteros and Alma Cafe. Colombia grows Arabica, and recently experiments have been conducted on growing Robusta.

Excelso is an export standard that regulates the number of defects in green coffee and the quality of the cup.

Supremo is sub-standard for big sized beans.

EP (European Preparation) specifies that the raw beans are all hand sorted to minimize defect tolerance.

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
